Heart Math Tutoring is looking for 40 volunteers to support 30 elementary students at Ladson Elementary from January – May 2022!

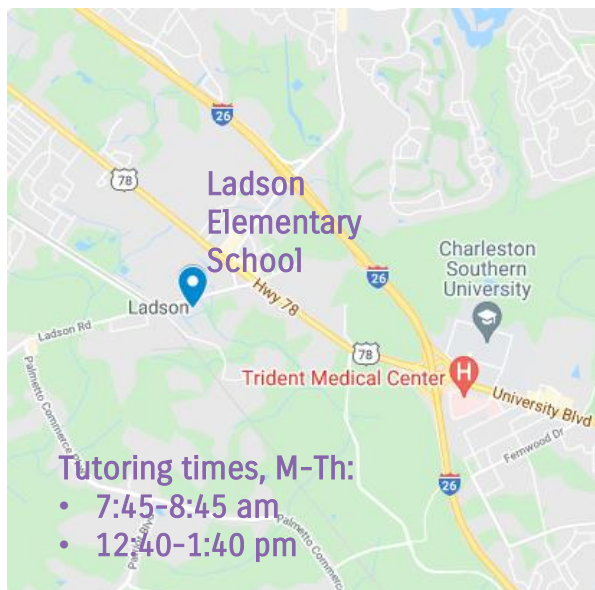
Heart Provides:

** Note: Math and tutoring experience are not required! If you can add 4+3, you are qualified!**



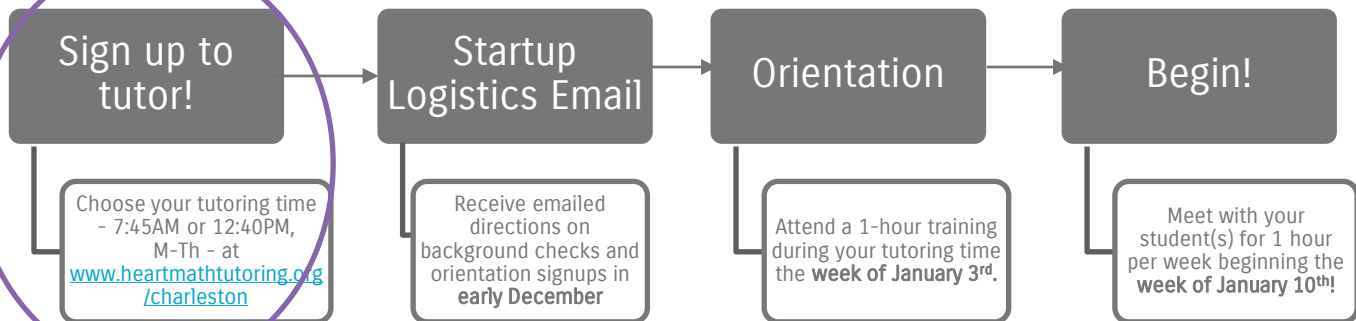

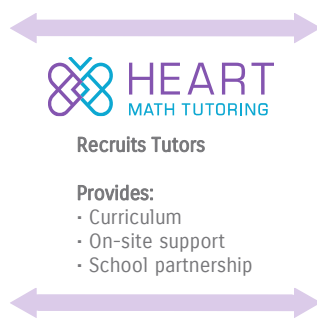

MORE INFORMATION

HMT is the link between volunteers and students, for successful experiences in math.

Students

- Only 52% of Charleston area students meet or exceed grade level expectations in grades 3-5 math (2019 SC READY)
- Many will fall further behind because of poor number sense
- All can succeed with one-on-one, targeted instruction



Volunteers

- Large, untapped pool of community members
- Willing to help but need tools and support
- Have limited time, and quality of past tutoring experiences may be varied

Want to make a difference in a student's life in just one hour a week? Tutor with Heart Math Tutoring at Ladson Elementary in CCSD starting January 3rd, 2022!

Structure

- Schools nominate students in grades 1-5 who are below grade level in math.
- Heart assesses students to determine individual gaps and then pairs them with **weekly tutors** during the school day, **targeted lessons**, and **staff support**.

Results

- **98%** of over students in the in-person model have **met program growth goals**, set with guidance from elementary math specialists at UNC Charlotte and Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools.
- **90%+** of teachers annually report **increased student confidence/ enthusiasm** towards math.
- **99%** of volunteers surveyed to date **rated their experience positive**.



Volunteers

- Heart volunteers provide one-on-one tutoring for 30 minutes or 1 hour each week, delivering Heart's effective curriculum and acting as a positive influence.
