Heart Math Tutoring Receives \$250,000 PROMISE GRANT from National Nonprofit Accelerate to Make High-Impact Tutoring Sustainable and Cost-Effective

HMT gives young students successful experiences in math through 1:1 tutoring delivered during the school day by supervised volunteers.

Charlotte, N.C. (May 25, 2023) — Heart Math Tutoring today announced it will receive a \$250,000 PROMISE GRANT from Accelerate, a national nonprofit working to make high-impact tutoring a standard feature of the American school day. HMT will use this grant to further scale the tutoring program in Charlotte, North Carolina and expand to other regions.

"We are excited to further maximize the positive difference Heart Math Tutoring volunteers and staff are making on elementary students' math skills and confidence through Accelerate's support with innovation, evaluation, and scale," said Heart Math Tutoring CEO Emily Gaffney.

With financial support from Accelerate, Heart Math Tutoring will further invest in volunteer tutor recruitment resources and will work closely with schools to ensure a growing number of students can participate in tutoring over time. HMT will also partner with a third-party researcher to pilot program innovations and measure and deepen student impact.

"The evidence behind tutoring as an intervention is strong and the field is making tremendous progress, but we still need more providers with a proven track record that can also scale," **said Accelerate CEO Kevin Huffman.** "Before the federal pandemic relief dollars dry up, we have an opportunity – and a responsibility – to identify these providers and ensure they are able to deliver cost-effective programs and present evidence that they get results for kids."

Heart Math Tutoring was selected for a PROMISE GRANT because of its commitment to developing and scaling a research-backed tutoring model that improves outcomes for all students, especially those in historically underserved communities.

Heart Math Tutoring is a Charlotte-based nonprofit with a mission to ensure that all elementary students develop the strong foundation in math and enthusiasm for academics needed for long-term success, by helping schools use volunteers as tutors. Community volunteers commit one hour per week to deliver an effective, hands-on curriculum through one-on-one tutoring sessions during the school day in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, Charleston County School District, and Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Schools. Heart is free of charge to families and focuses its support on students who do not have access to resources for private tutoring.
